## NWPCA CSF ELECTION SUMMIT

### Agenda for Sectoral and Provincial Elections

1. Delegates will be briefed on election process.
2. All delegates will be vetted.
3. Delegates will Elect 3 leaders for each sector, except PLHIV which elects 5.
4. Results will be declared.
5. Sectoral leaders including those from Labour, Traditional Leaders and Higher Education sector leaders will participate in Tier 2 elections (governance).
6. Elected District Chairs will participate in provincial elections.
7. The Provincial elections will follow the same process of sectoral elections for Tier 1 and 2. Thereafter, results will be declared.

### NB: No caucusing allowed during sectoral and provincial elections.

1. Kindly note that Tier 1 elections will require each sector to comply with the Rule of 10 requirements with exception of Disability, Sex Workers, LGBTQIA+, Health Professionals and Research Sectors.
2. Each candidate should bring along the following documents to be eligible for election:
  - 2.1. Identity document (ID) or Driver's license as proof of identity (Copies not allowed)
  - 2.2. Official letter from the organization's Executive Director or Senior Management endorsing your participation at the elections.
  - 2.3. The letter should show proof of the organization registration number or PBO/CBO number as well as nominating the member(s) to participate in the elections.
  - 2.4. Please note that No one will be allowed to participate in the elections without the above-mentioned documents.
