Pretoria: Following last week's successful hosting of the G20 Stakeholder Consultation session on Women Empowerment which was held at the North-West University, Potchefstroom campus, the Department of Women, Youth and Persons with Disabilities and the North West Provincial Government will this week hold the second and last G20 Stakeholder Consultation session on the Empowerment of Women, Youth and Persons with Disabilities Working Group at the MM Sebitloane Special School in Lokaleng village, Taung, on Friday, 02 May 2025.

The Stakeholders Consultation sessions serve as build-up activities ahead of next week's G20 Financial Inclusion Conference and the second G20 Technical Meeting on the Empowerment of Women Working Group at Sun City.
